## PARENTING PROGRAMS FOR PARENTS AND FAMILY

There are a variety of parenting programs available at different agencies across Newcastle and the Hunter.

### Programs and what they are about

Below is a summary of what each program includes and a detailed list of delivery locations follows:

**123 Magic and Emotion Coaching:** Learning to manage difficult behaviours with 2–12 yr olds using calm parenting and setting clear expectations.

**All Dads Online**: Men who have a fathering role and want to improve relationships with their children.

**Black Box Parenting:** This program is designed specifically for the challenges of parenting after violence, learning about the impact of trauma, how the attachment can disrupt and how to repair your parenting bond.

**Bringing Up Great Kids**: A program that will help you learn more about parenting methods & build the foundations for great relationship with your child.

**Circle of Security:** This program is designed for parents and carers of children 0-12 yr who want to strengthen bonds with their children and support to help their children build secure relationships.

**Creating Emotionally Resilient Families**: This program delivers strategies for parents wanting to raise resilient children and develop a strong emotionally connected family.

**Fathers and Men with a Fathering Role:** Information for individual family assistance in home or in centre with a variety of group programs.

**Keeping Children Safe**: This program promotes care and protection of children and young people helping them to understand child protection language and terms and aims to increase their knowledge and understanding of issues involved in the abuse and neglect of children.

**Keeping Kids in Mind:** This program is for separated parents who want understanding and strategies to support their children following separation.

**Kids in Care:** Trauma-informed workshop for parents whose children were removed and placed in care to help them through loss and grief, as well as develop tools to manage and overcome difficult emotions.

Kids in Focus: A program for supporting your kids after separation.

**Mindful Parenting:** A 24-week program for parents living with "distress, impulsiveness, confusion and black & white thinking".

My Kids and Me: This program is for parents whose children are in care. The aim is to give parents an opportunity to reflect on their experiences and provide an opportunity for change that can strengthen the relationship between parent and child.

**No Scaredy Cats:** A program that supports parents to recognise anxiety developing in their child and how to implement practical skills to encourage resilient thinking.

**Peaceful Parents**: This program is a mindfulness and positive program aimed at increasing resilience in both parents and children.

**Raising the Growing Child:** This course can help parents gain some direction about how they want to parent in the future, discover and understand the origins of their child behaviour and learn how to support their children to manage their own emotions and behaviour.

**Seasons for Growth**: A program for parents to better understand the experience of death, separation and divorce from a child's perspective.

**Tuning Into Kids:** Teaches parents how to use emotion coaching to help their children understand, regulate and work through their emotions.

**Tuning Into Teens**: This program is designed to support & help parents with their teenage children to control, understand and respond to their emotions.
